Differentiation:

Beginner Tick the sentence that does not use a full stop or a question mark; using statements and questions; simple sentences. Aimed at Year 2 Developing.

Easy Tick the sentence that does not use a full stop, question mark or an exclamation mark; using statements, questions or commands; simple and mult clause sentences. Aimed at Year 2 Expected.

Tricky Tick the sentence that does not use a full stop, question mark or an exclamation mark; using statements, questions or commands; mult clause sentences and some overlap with vocabulary (what/how used at the start of exclamations/questions). Aimed at Year 2 Greater Depth.
