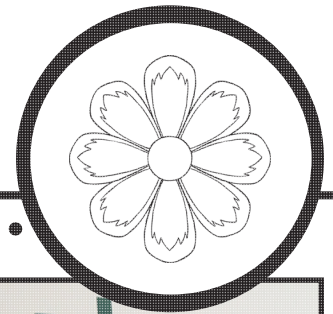
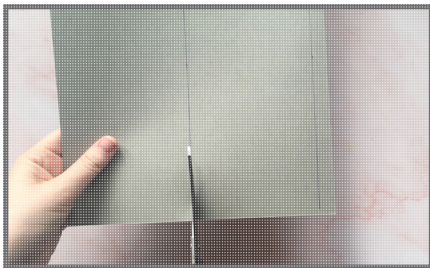
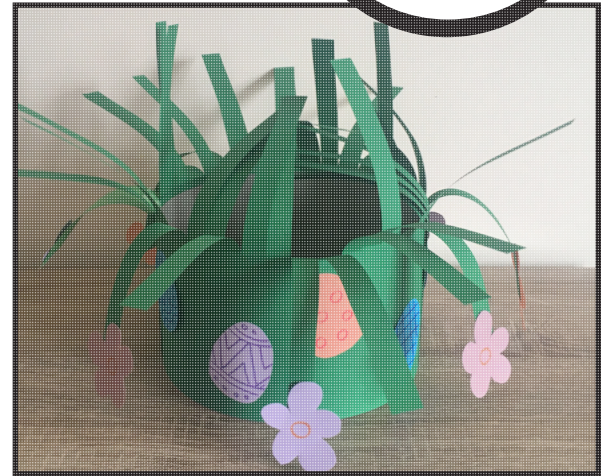


Spring Hat Craft

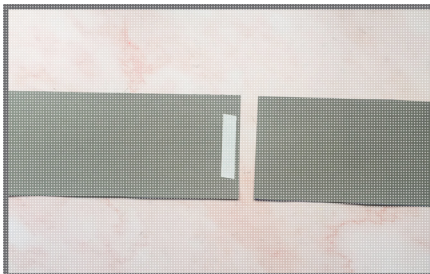


You will need:

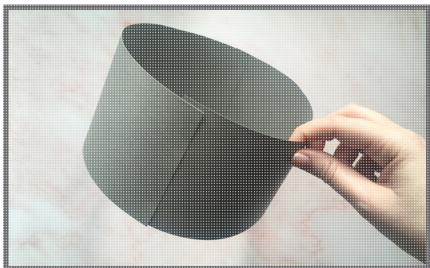
- A piece of card
- 2 sheets of green paper
- Colourful pieces of paper
- Scissors
- Glue or double-sided sticky tape
- Felt tip pens or pencils



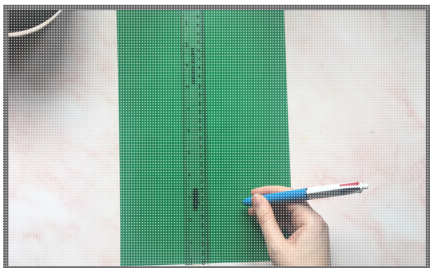
1) First, decide how tall you would like your hat to be. We used 10cm. Then, draw two strips this width along the length of the the piece of card. Cut them out.



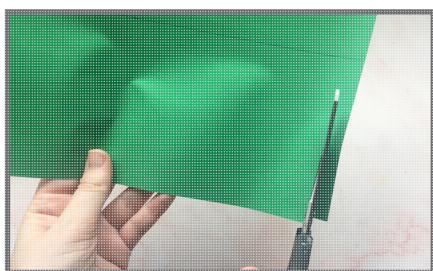
2) Now, use double-sided sticky tape or glue to attach the two strips of card together to make one long strip of card.



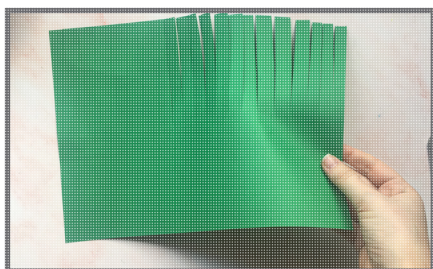
3) Then, measure the strip around your head to decide how large it needs to be. Use glue or double-sided sticky tape to secure the long strip in a band of this size. You have the main template for your Spring hat craft.



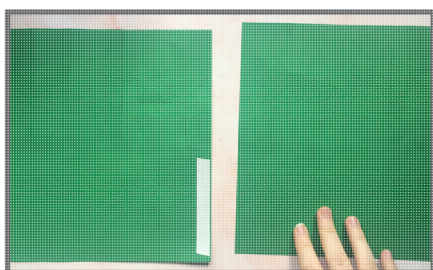
4) Next, get your green paper or card. Use a ruler to mark another strip, the same width as the strips drawn in step 1, along the whole length of the paper. This is your no cut zone.



5) Next, starting at the other end of the paper, create snips from the longest edge up to the guide line you just marked.



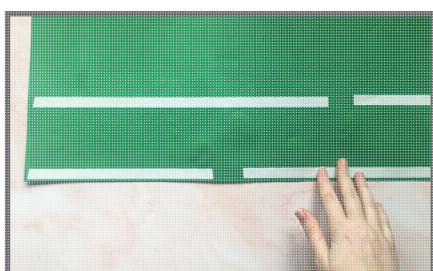
6) Continue along the whole length of the paper. You should have a strip the same width as your hat band, and then above it your grass fringe.



7) Repeat this step with another sheet of paper and then attach the two sheets together using glue or double-sided sticky tape.



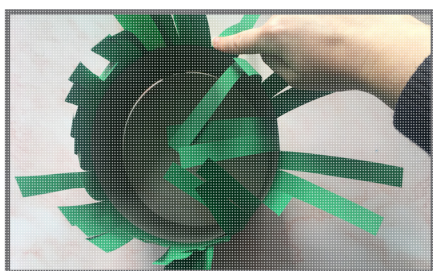
8) Next, decorate the band of your green paper. You could add extra snips of paper, paint or drawn designs. Turn your hat into an Easter bonnet, or choose a fun Spring theme.



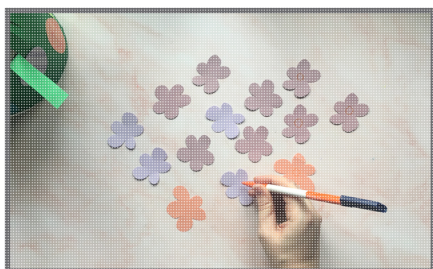
9) Then, turn the paper over and add strips of glue or double-sided sticky tape along the top and bottom of the band.



10) Then roll the card band you made earlier along these strips of glue or tape to wrap the headband in your decorated Spring grass.



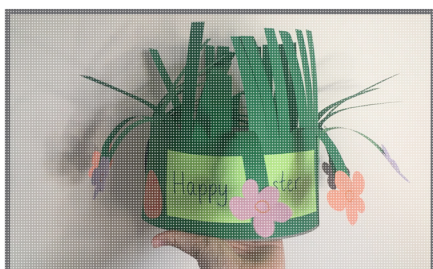
11) Now, bend some of the strips inwards and some of the strips outwards so the fringe looks like grass.



12) Then, cut out flower shapes from a mixture of paper and card. You can then decorate them with felt tip pens.



13) Attach each flower to the end of one of the strips which hangs outside of your Spring hat.



14) You have created a fun Spring hat with bouncy grass and flowers. This is a fab DIY Easter bonnet which adds a super spring to your step.
