Key terms:

Pioneer	A person who explores/ settles somewhere or develops/ applies something new.
Inventor	A person who makes new inventions, devices that perform some kind of function.
Passion	A strong feeling or emotion.
Artefacts	Objects that are made, used, or modified by humans and give us information about life in the past.
Sequence	A set of related events, movements or items that follow each other in a particular order.
Source	Someone or something that supplies information.



The Beatles:

The Beatles were an English rock band, formed in Liverpool in 1960, that comprised John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr. As the first band to broadcast their music live and make a music video they became pioneers in the music industry.



Steve Jobs:

Steve Jobs co-founded Apple Computers with Steve Wozniak. Under Jobs' guidance, the company pioneered a series of revolutionary technologies, including the iPhone and iPad. He was born in 1955 and died in 2011.



Easton LaChapelle:

At just 14 years old Easton created his first prosthetic arm out of Lego. Since then he has founded a business called Unlimited Tomorrow, which produces prosthetic limbs using 3D printing.
