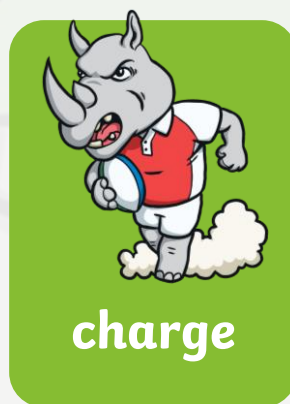
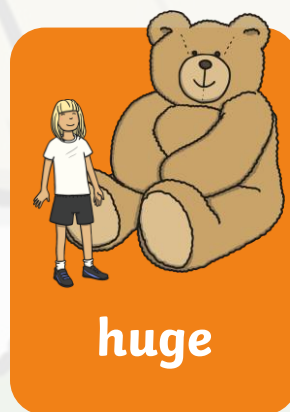
/j/ Spelt '-dge'

At the end of a word, the /j/ sound is spelt '**-dge**' after the **short** vowel sounds /a/, /e/, /i/, /o/, /u/.

the /j/ sound is spelt '**-ge**' at the **end** of a word.

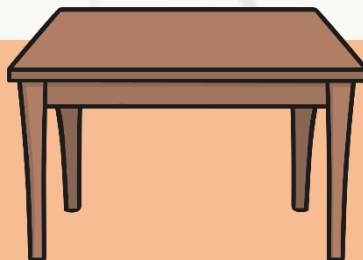

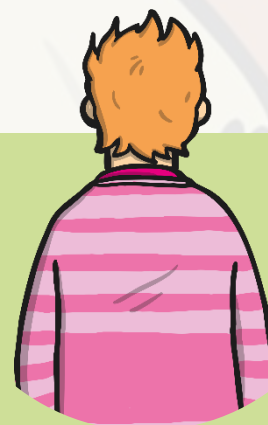
