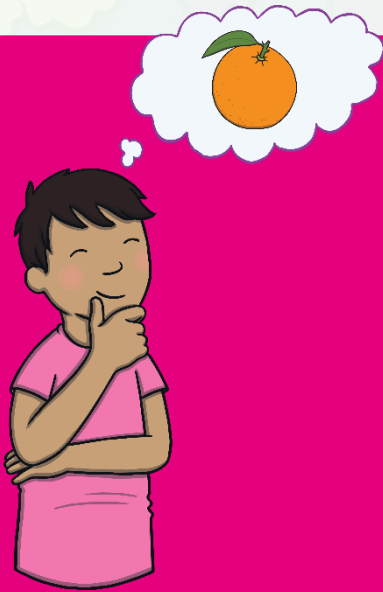


The /o/ Sound Spelt with 'a' after a 'w' or 'qu'



The Sound /o/ Spelt 'a'

The sound /o/ is **often** spelt with 'o' **but** if the sound /o/ comes after the letter 'w' it is spelt with the letter 'a', for example:



want



watch



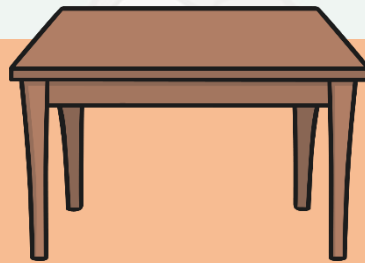
wander

The Sound /o/ Spelt 'a'

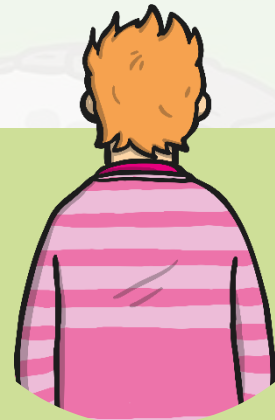
If the sound /o/ comes after the letters 'qu' it is also spelt with 'a', such as in the words: **quantity**, **squash**, **quality**, **squabble**, **squad**, **quad** and **quarrel**.



Can you air write an 'a' with your finger?

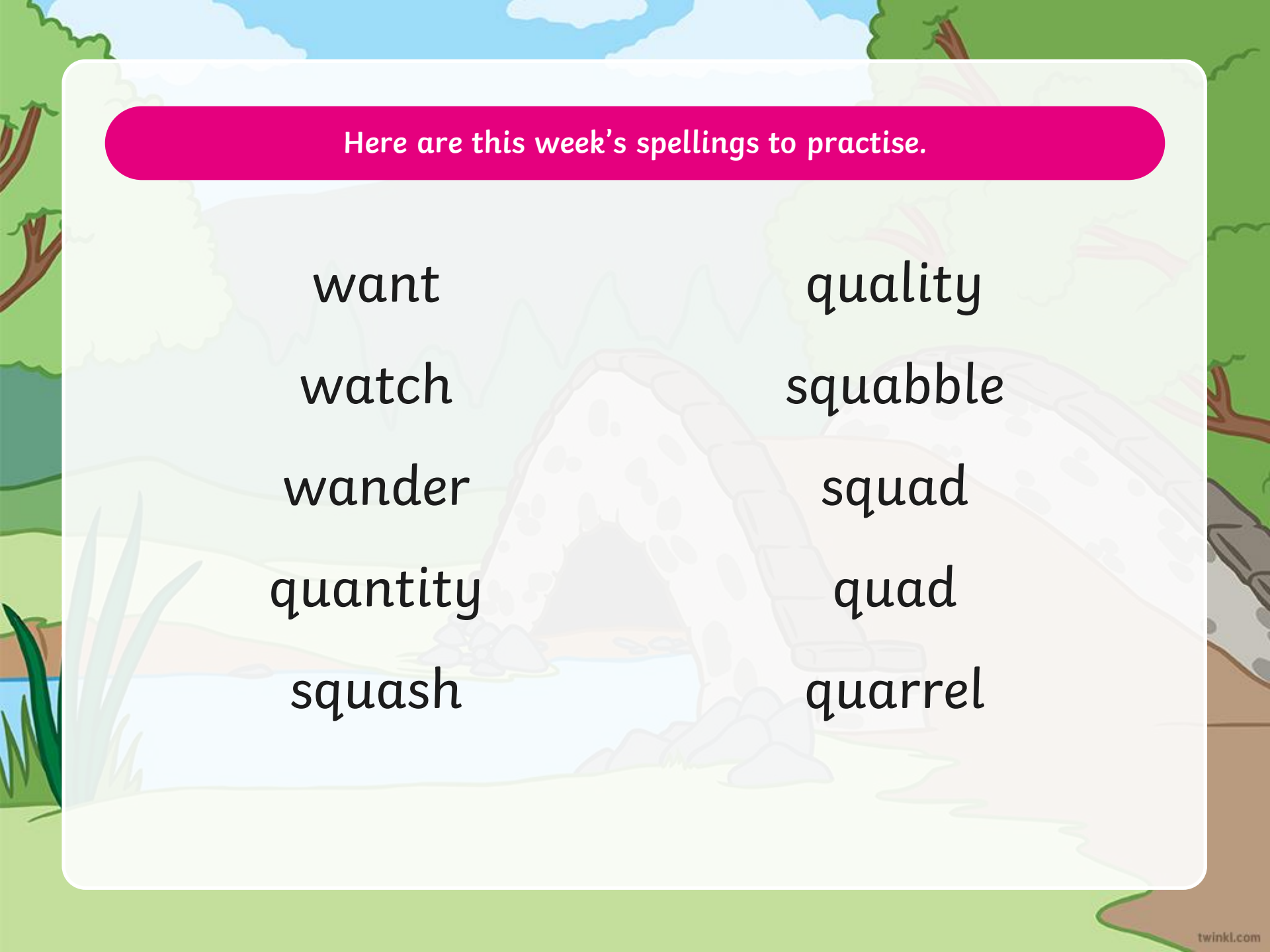


Using your finger, can you write an 'a' on your table?
