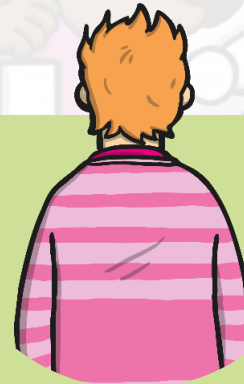

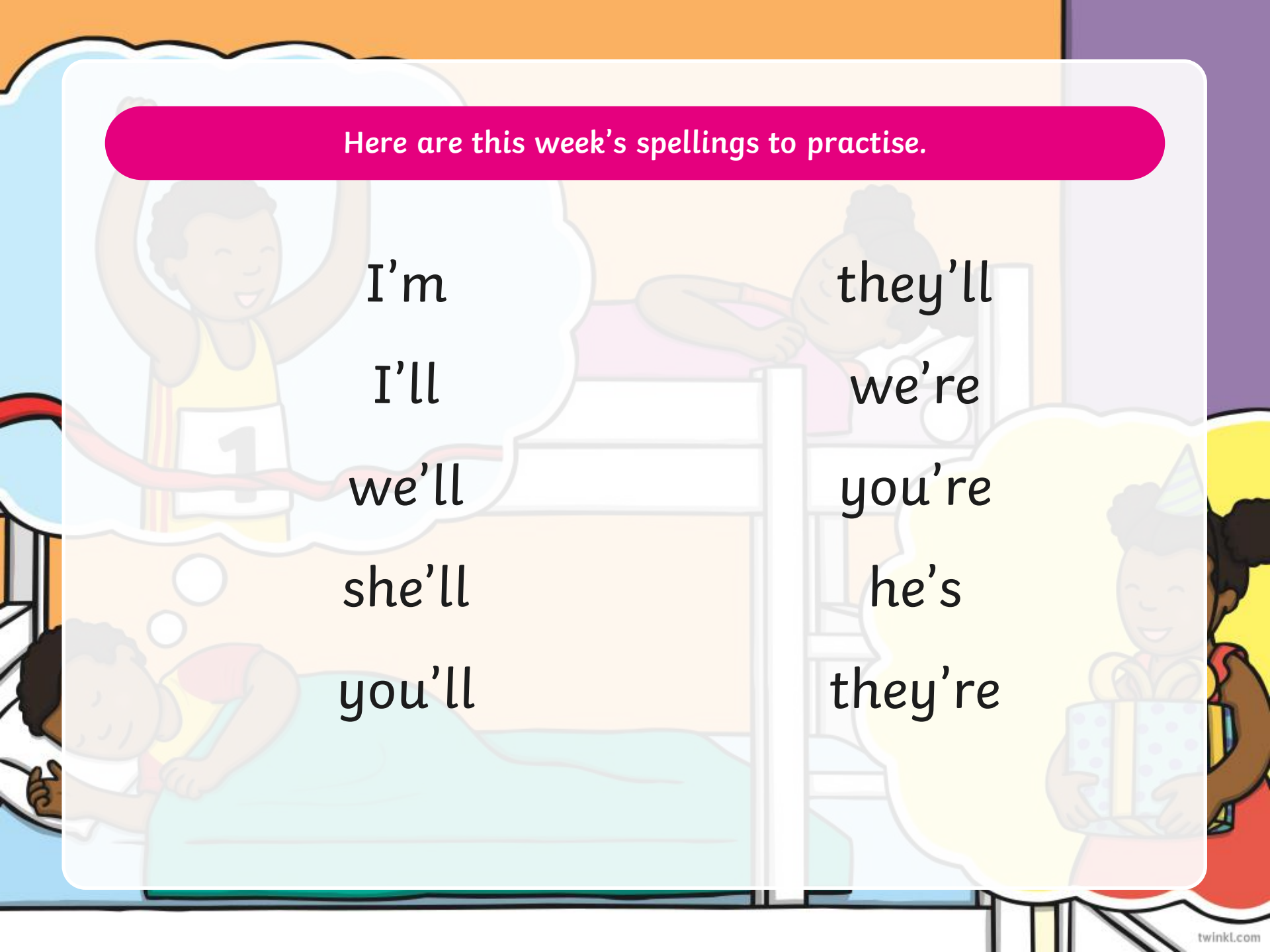


Can you write one of these contractions in the air with your finger?
