Monarchy	A monarchy is a form of government that has a single person.
Generation	The people in a family born and living during the same time.
Family Tree	A Family Tree is a chart showing all the members of a family.
Queen/King	Someone who rules a country, because of inheritance.
Chronology	Something arranged in order of time.
The Royal Family	A royal family is the immediate family of a king or queen.
Reign	To have complete and widespread control or influence.
