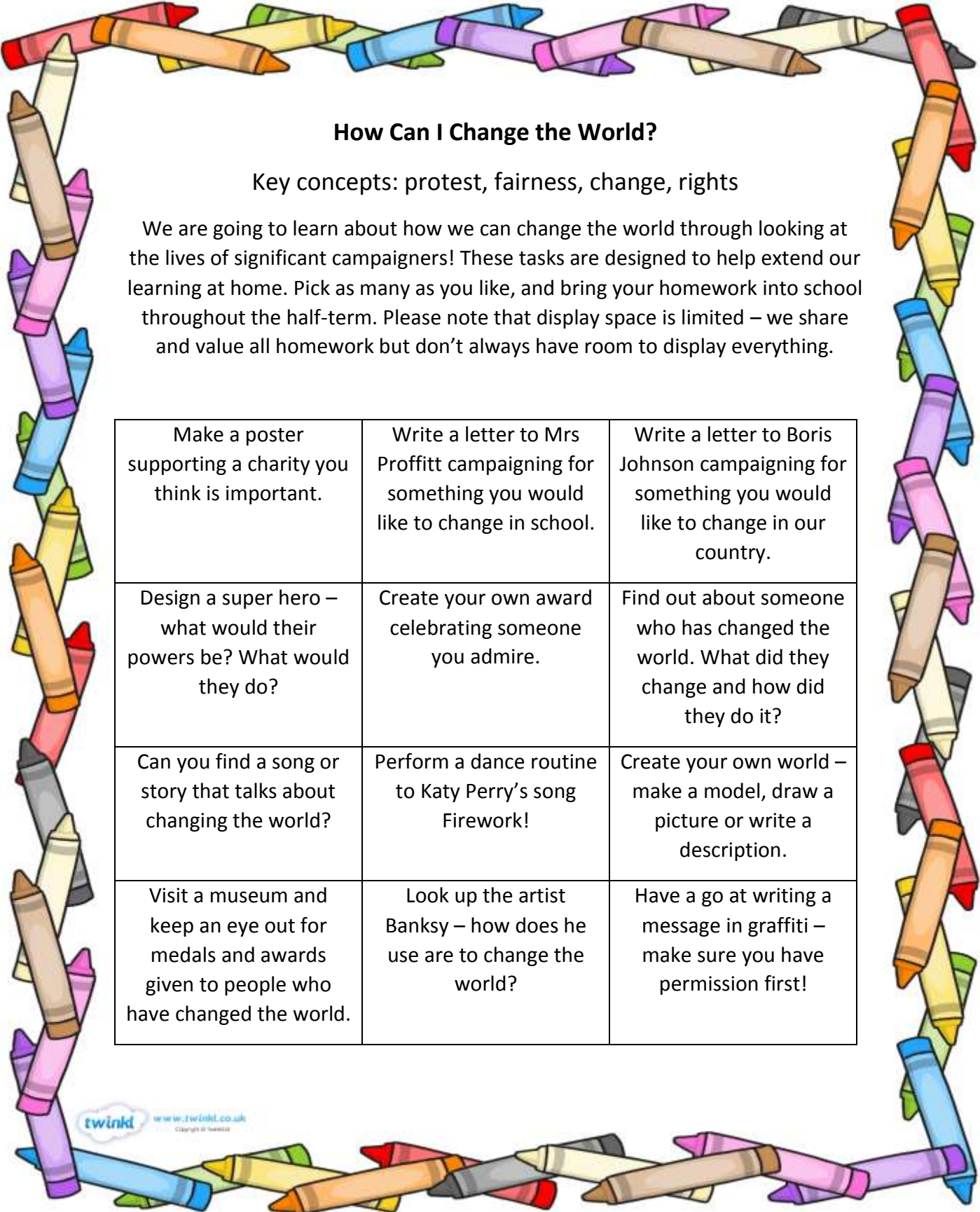




How Can I Change the World?

We are going to learn about how we can change the world through looking at the lives of significant campaigners! These tasks are designed to help extend our learning at home. Pick as many as you like, and bring your homework into school throughout the half-term. Please note that display space is limited – we share and value all homework but don't always have room to display everything.

Make a poster supporting a charity you think is important.	Write a letter to Mrs Proffitt campaigning for something you would like to change in school.	Write a letter to Boris Johnson campaigning for something you would like to change in our country.
Design a super hero – what would their powers be? What would they do?	Create your own award celebrating someone you admire.	Find out about someone who has changed the world. What did they change and how did they do it?
Can you find a song or story that talks about changing the world?	Perform a dance routine to Katy Perry's song Firework!	Create your own world – make a model, draw a picture or write a description.
Visit a museum and keep an eye out for medals and awards given to people who have changed the world.	Look up the artist Banksy – how does he use art to change the world?	Have a go at writing a message in graffiti – make sure you have permission first!
