Google Classroom

During this time, Google Classroom will be our main source of communication. As before, daily maths, reading, writing and SPaG tasks will be uploaded to Google Classroom as well as weekly science, computing, music, RE, PE and topic projects. The children will be able to access, edit and submit their completed tasks through Google Classroom, or alternatively they can email any work to their class teacher. If you have any difficulties logging into Google Classroom, please don't hesitate to contact us.

'Face to Face' Support

After careful consideration, we have formed and finalised our home learning approach in order to best support both those children working at home as well as those remaining in school. We understand that in many families, parents and siblings will also need to access devices as we all adjust to working from home. With this in mind, we have made the decision to offer a flexible approach that enables families to access and complete work at their convenience.

Each morning, we will be hosting a virtual meeting using 'Google Classroom Meet'. This will give the children the opportunity to 'meet' with us and their peers, to discuss the upcoming work and to ask any questions they may have. Could we please ask that all children have accessed, explored and read the tasks for the day before entering the virtual meeting so that they are prepared with any questions they need to ask?

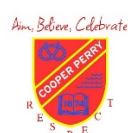
Our 'Google Meets' will take place daily at the following times:

Year 5	9:00
Year 6	9:30

A link to the session will appear on their Google Classroom class page a couple of minutes before the meeting is due to begin and will be shared via Parentmail prior to the meeting.

It is now expected that **all** children attend these sessions so that we can ensure we have had 'face-to-face contact' with every child each day. If your child is unwell, and therefore cannot attend, please email their class teacher to let them know.

In addition to this, the Year 5 and 6 team will be hosting a weekly wellbeing virtual session, where the children will get the opportunity to interact with their teacher and each other.



Virtual Support

In addition to our morning meetings, a member of the Upper Key Stage 2 team will be available to offer virtual support throughout the morning. This means that between 10:00 and 12:30, the children can re-enter our Google meeting to ask questions, receive support or seek feedback on their work, should they wish to. The purpose of this support is to offer guidance and intervention when it is needed for individual children. As we will only be able to support one child at any one time, could we please ask that when the children do not require additional support, they leave the 'Google Meet' and only re-enter if they require further guidance or help. To gain access to this virtual support, the children will need to follow the 'Google Meet' link, which will be shared on our class stream (on Google Classrooms) and will be sent out via Parent Mail each morning.

If you do not have digital or online access, please contact us as soon as possible, and paper-based packs, including printed materials can be organised to support learning at home.

Marking and Feedback

As always, all maths, reading and SPaG work will be uploaded with the relevant answers, and similar to in school, we would ask that the children self-mark their work once it is complete. Once marked, children should upload their work to Google Classroom or send it via email to receive feedback from their teacher.

Mrs Georgiou will be available to provide feedback between 10:00am and 12:30pm Monday to Thursday, and you can contact her via email.

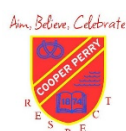
As all members of the Upper Key Stage 2 team will be spending time in school and time supporting those learning at home, it may take us a little longer to reply – please bear with us.

Pupil Engagement

Government guidelines state that children in Key Stage 2 should be completing a minimum of **4 hours of learning each day** whilst working at home. In order to ensure pupil engagement, the Upper Key Stage 2 team will:

- Register and monitor the children taking part in the daily Google Meets and virtual support.
- Register and monitor work submission, either on Goggle Classroom or via email.
- Ensure that they have had contact with every family on a weekly basis.

If it is proving challenging to engage your child in remote learning, please don't hesitate to contact us – we are here to support you!



If we have not had contact with a family, or received evidence of children's work, we will follow up as part of our duty to ensure the education and well-being of our children.
