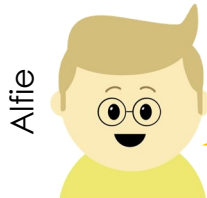

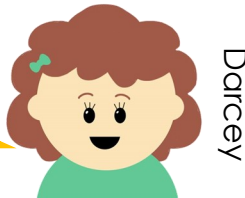

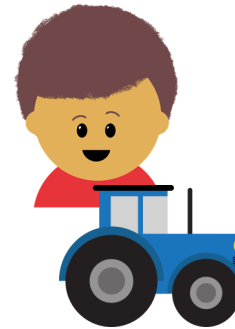

Marlon has added relative clauses to the sentences.

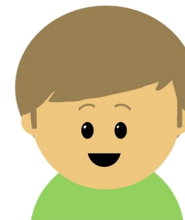
