1. Which kind of trees shed their leaves in autumn?

2. Give two examples of deciduous trees.

3. What are deciduous trees unable to do in winter?

Deciduous trees are unable to make their own food in winter.

4. Give two examples of evergreen trees.

5. Why can evergreen trees make their own food all year-round?

This is because they do not lose their leaves.

6. Describe the leaves of evergreen trees.

The leaves of evergreen trees are thick and waxy.

7. During winter, what are evergreen trees able to store inside their leaves?

Evergreen trees are able to store water inside their leaves (which does not freeze).

8. Deciduous trees remain **dormant** during the winter. What does this mean?

This means that the tree slows down and does not make any food. It is still alive, but it does not grow.
