Y1 Exemplar Checklist	✓
Uses phonics to help with spelling.	✓
Spells common exception words.	✓
Adds -s or -es to make plurals correctly.	✓
Uses the prefix un-.	✓
Adds the suffix -ing, -ed, -er and -est to root words.	✓
Uses and spells compound words e.g. sunflower, cowboy.	✓
Tries to write lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.	✓
Writes capital letters.	✓
Writes sentences in order to make a short story or non-fiction text.	✓
Re-reads their writing to check that it makes sense.	✓
Tries to add adjectives to describe.	✓
Uses finger spaces.	✓
Uses the joining word (conjunction) 'and' to link ideas and sentences.	✓
Tries to use capital letters and full stops. ABC.	✓
Tries to use question marks and exclamation marks. ? !	✓
Uses capital letters for names, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'.	✓

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
