Learning:

Maths	Daily maths lessons following the White Rose scheme of learning.	Tasks can be completed by printing sheets, or by writing answers onto paper if sheets cannot be printed at home.
English	Daily English lessons using resources from Oak National.	Tasks can be completed by printing sheets, or by writing answers onto paper if sheets cannot be printed at home.
Reading	Year One will receive directed phonics activities. All children should read widely and be read to regularly.	
Science	Weekly science lesson available on the class page.	Tasks will be practical where possible or can be completed as English and Maths.
Topic	We will provide a topic web with a range of activities. This will be updated after three weeks.	Tasks will be practical where possible or can be completed as English and Maths.
Art	Weekly art lesson available on the class page.	Tasks will be practical where possible or can be completed as English and Maths.
Computing	Weekly computing lesson available on the class page.	Tasks will be practical where possible or can be completed as English and Maths.
RE	Weekly RE lesson available on the class page.	Tasks will be practical where possible or can be completed as English and Maths.

A daily video update will be shared on each class page. These will summarise the learning for the day and provide a regular opportunity for children to see and hear from their class teacher.

Three zoom meetings will also be scheduled for each class. These will be facilitated by Mrs Davies or Miss Phillips and will last for 30-40 minutes. These sessions will not be taught lessons. They will give children chance to see their classmates and have live check-ins. Staff will plan a focus for each session: story-time, show and tell, circle time style games. The timings will be shared ahead of each week to help parents plan.
