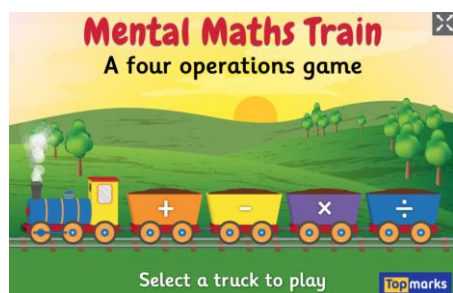
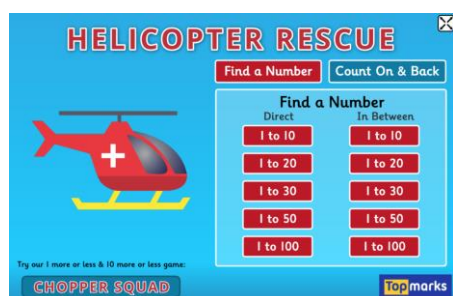


Addition and Subtraction Games.



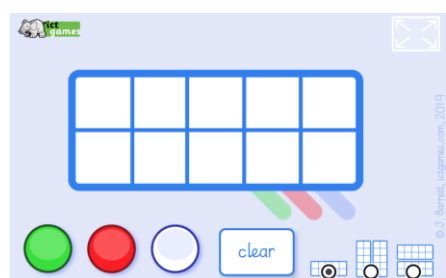

This maths game focuses on the essential vocabulary of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. It can help children to understand what type of calculation they have to do when faced with word problems.



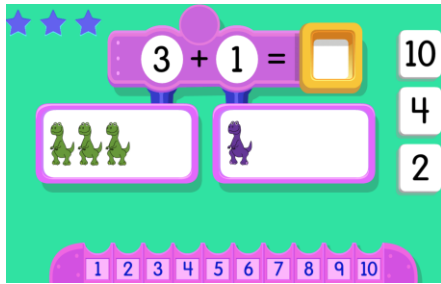
