Google Classroom

The children will have access to daily support and learning tasks on Google Classroom. The children will access this to view pre-recorded lesson inputs and tasks for English, Maths and Reading as well as a range of foundation subjects - Topic, Science, Music, French, Art and Computing. Lesson inputs will be pre-recorded and downloadable to ensure we provide a high quality and easily accessible learning opportunity for all children.

The children will use their Google Suite account to complete tasks and submit through the 'Hand it in' function.

'Face to Face Support'

Our approach bears in mind the challenges of parental home working and sibling home learning too. As a result, our offer provides the children with the opportunity to see their peers daily and have that early morning communication in the form of a 'Google Meet'. They will also have access to personalised support each morning in the form of 'Google Meet' workshops, if they have learning questions and concerns. The children have had rules provided for their online conduct during the 'Google Meets', we would ask that all pupils read this prior to entering their first session.

- The 'Google Meet' early morning session will be at 9.40am daily for both Year 3 and 4.
- The opportunity for 'Google Meet' workshops will be between 12-12.20pm daily.

Additional Virtual Support

As well as daily meets with your class teacher, some pupils will have access to 1:1 and small group 'Google Meets' to support their wellbeing, nurture them further, as well as assisting them further with the anticipated transition back into school. These will be run by either Mrs Davies or Mrs Squires. Please could parents check their parentmail communication to see if their child is in one of these groups. These 'Google Meets' will be communicated after initial consent is gained via parentmail.

Marking and Feedback

The children's morning activities, predominantly Maths will have the relevant answers provided where possible for children to self-mark. This will be to encourage the children to become more independent, motivated and provide opportunities for them to celebrate their successes. Other work e.g. English, Science, Reading will be submitted on Google and their class teacher will mark and provide feedback.

All members of the Lower Key Stage 2 team will be in school with key worker children during various parts of the week so please bear with us as we reply to your emails. You may also submit comments with your child's work through Google when it is handed in.

Expectations

It is expected that the children complete the majority, if not, all of the tasks. A minimum requirement is:

- A daily Maths lesson and associated tasks
- A daily English and reading lesson and associated tasks.

Please supplement your child's learning with regular breaks and ensure they are maintaining good levels of exercise so they have a healthy body, mind and overall wellbeing during this time.
