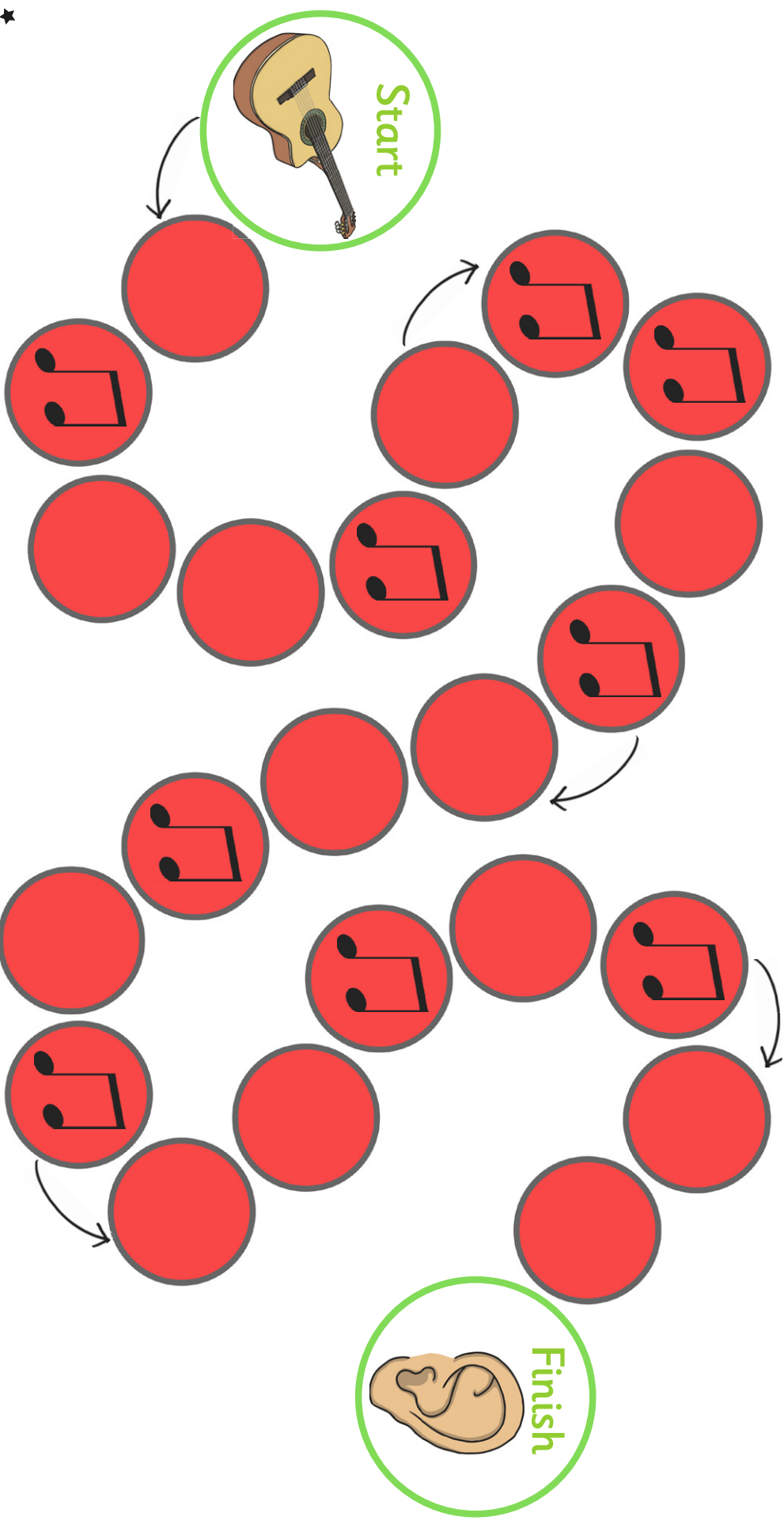


Good Vibrations

You will need one counter per player and a 6-sided die. Cut out the question cards before you play
